Authorised Classification Societies - Recognised Organisations & Recognised Security Organisations

Guidance for Bahamas Recognised Organisations, Bahamas Approved Nautical Inspectors, Ship Owners, Managers, Masters and Seafarers

1. Purpose

1.1. This bulletin details the organisations to which The Bahamas has entrusted survey, audit and certification under the provisions of the relevant regulations of the Conventions to which The Commonwealth of The Bahamas is a party.

2. Recognised Organisations & Recognised Security Organisations

- 2.1. The following twelve (12) organisations have been authorised to carry out statutory survey, audit and certification of Bahamian ships and audit and certification of Companies operating Bahamian ships.
 - American Bureau of Shipping (ABS)
 - Bureau Veritas (BV)
 - China Classification Society (CCS)
 - Croatian Register of Shipping (CRS)
 - DNV GL AS¹ (DNV-GL)
 - Indian Register of Shipping (IRS)
 - Korean Register of Shipping (KR)
 - Lloyd's Register (LR)
 - Nippon Kaiji Kyokai (Class NK NKK)
 - Registro Italiano Navale (RINA)
 - Polski Rejestr Statkow (Polish Register of Shipping PRS)
 - Russian Maritime Register of Shipping (RS)

3. Authorisation

- 3.1. The Bahamas has authorised the organisations listed above in accordance with IMO Assembly Resolution A.739(18) "Guidelines For The Authorization Of Organizations Acting On Behalf Of The Administration" and IMO Assembly Resolution A.789(19) "Specifications On The Survey And Certification Functions Of Recognized Organizations Acting On Behalf Of The Administration".
- 3.2. The organisations are further authorised in accordance with Regulations 5.1.1.3 and 5.1.2 of the ILO Maritime Labour Convention, 2006.
