

The first guide provides definitions, an explanation of the causes and the consequences of child labour, and the rationale for why enterprises should not employ children. In short, it provides an understanding of the issues.

The two subsequent guides explain what can be done about child labour from the business point of view. Guide Two is addressed to enterprises and explains their options and possible strategies for eliminating child labour. Guide Three is about the collective role that employers' organizations and other business associations can play in helping their members on this important topic.
