High smartphone access within refugee communities offers new opportunities for mobile based services

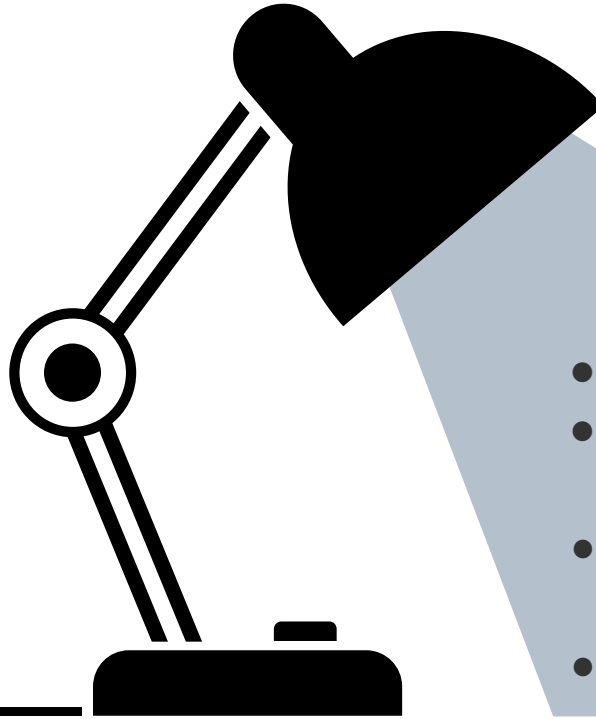
Young refugees are more likely to use smartphones than older refugees

Income level likely to influence the type of mobile device ownership

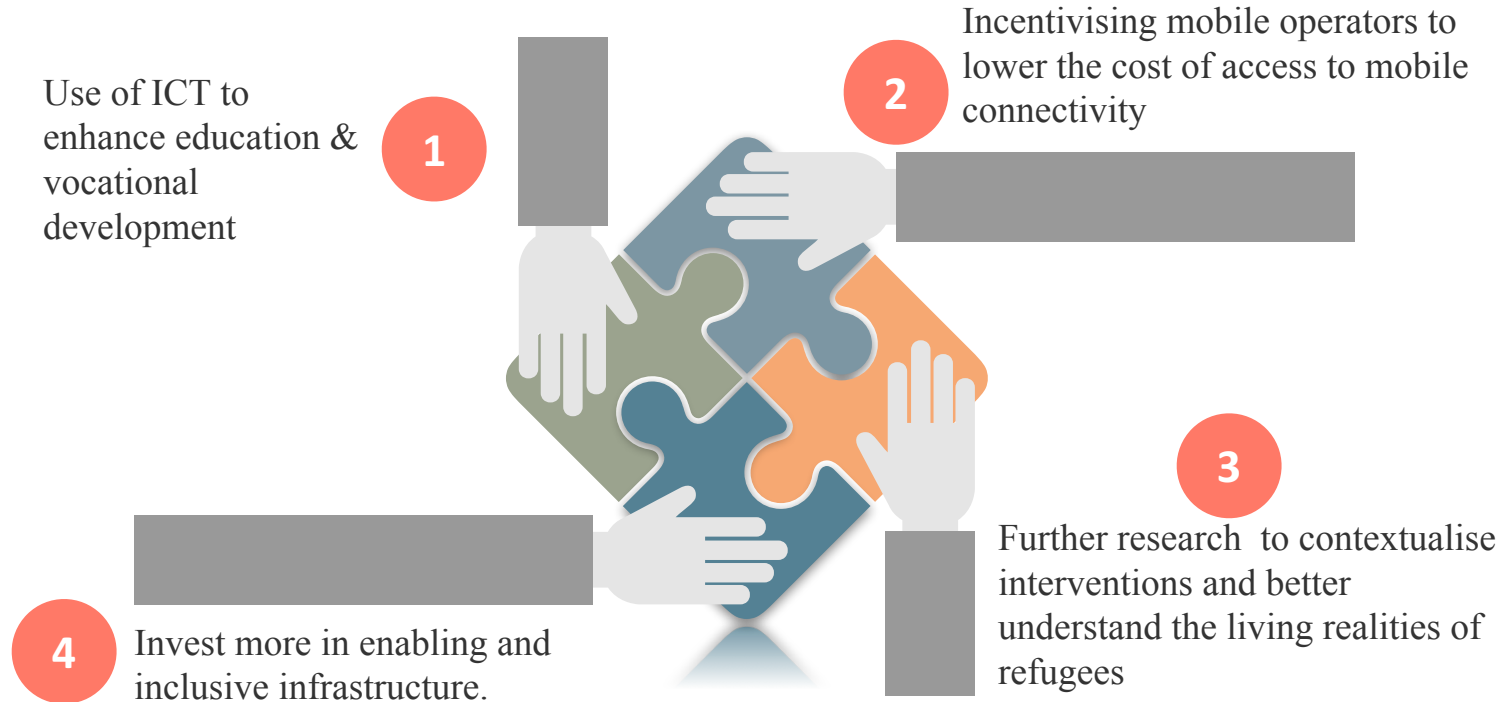
“There are opportunities, but they are not many or known to the majority of those who should be benefiting.”

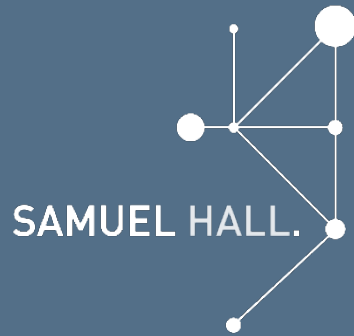
Barriers: Accessing Services Over the Internet
