Second Advisory Committee meeting on Integrating Trade and Decent Work May 2022

The <u>virtual meeting</u> provided an opportunity to share information on the latest developments related to trade and labour issues among tripartite members. RESEARCH also presented a draft study on "Promoting and enforcing compliance of labour provisions in trade agreements".



LP Hub - Updates September 2022

The <u>Labour Provisions in Trade Agreements Hub</u> was recently updated, covering now 356 RTAs of which 113 include labour provisions.

The Multinational Enterprises and Enterprise Engagement Unit (ILO/MULTI) developed a list of references to the MNE Declaration in trade and investment agreements based on the LP Hub.

Latin America July 2022

In the context of the <u>CERALC project</u>, ILO/MULTI co-organized the <u>VII United Nations Regional</u> Forum on Business and Human Rights for Latin <u>America and the Caribbean</u>, where the LP Hub was also presented (see above).



Africa July 2022

ILO/ACTRAV is implementing a four-year project titled "Decent Work in Trade and Investment

Agreements: Role and Actions of Trade Unions in Africa", with target countries being Namibia, Rwanda, Senegal, and Uganda. Marva Corley-Coulibaly participated in the hybrid <u>opening</u> workshop in Windoek, Namibia, with a presentation on "Free trade agreements and labour provisions". Asia and the Pacific June 2022

Christian Viegelahn delivered a presentation on labour provisions at the <u>2022 ASEAN-CER</u> <u>Integration Partnership Forum</u>, focused on how environmental and labour concerns and priorities can be approached in a trade context.



Middle East and North Africa May 2022

The Mainstreaming Employment into Trade and Investment in the Southern Neighbourhood (<u>METI</u>) programme recently launched Policy Working Groups in Jordan and Egypt, and published a <u>Thematic Report</u> as well as a <u>Country Report for Jordan</u>.



Europe and Central Asia March 2022

In March, the Cotton Campaign lifted the labourmotivated global boycott of Uzbekistan cotton products, with the move welcomed by the ILO. The ILO also conducted an <u>interview with</u> <u>economist Zuzana Zavarska</u> on the potential for nearshoring to create economic opportunities for the Western Balkans.
