Seventh question before the Committee

Appointment to the ILO Staff Pension Committee (United Nations Joint Staff Pension Board)

- 1. In accordance with article 6(c) of the Regulations of the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Fund, as a member organization of the Fund, the ILO has a Staff Pension Committee composed of nine members, three appointed by the International Labour Conference, three by the Director-General and three by officials participating in the Fund. Each of the three groups can appoint an equal number of alternate members. Since 1992, appointments within the "Conference" group reflect tripartite representation.
- **2.** The following are current members appointed by the Conference to the ILO Staff Pension Committee for a three-year term ending 8 October 2019:

- **3.** The Workers' group has proposed that Mr B. Thibault and Mr P. Coutaz be reappointed for the period from 9 October 2019 to 30 June 2020. Proposals for the remaining period of the term, 1 July 2020 to 8 October 2022, will be put forward following the Governing Body elections in June 2020.
- **4.** No proposals have been received from the Government and Employers' groups with respect to renewals or new appointments.
- 5. It is proposed that the International Labour Conference authorize the Governing Body to provisionally fill any vacant titular and alternate member positions for the term 9 October 2019 to 8 October 2022 on the understanding that any appointments thus made would be confirmed by the International Labour Conference at its 109th Session (June 2020).

Draft decision

6. The Finance Committee accordingly submits the following draft resolution for adoption by the Conference:

The General Conference of the International Labour Organization,

Appoints Mr B. Thibault as member, and Mr P. Coutaz, as alternate member, to the ILO Staff Pension Committee (United Nations Joint Staff Pension Board), for the term of office from 9 October 2019 to 30 June 2020.

Authorizes the Governing Body to provisionally fill vacant members' and alternate members' positions of the respective groups to the ILO Staff Pension Committee, on the understanding that any appointments thus made would be confirmed by the International Labour Conference at it its 109th Session (June 2020).
