It is facilitated by ILO OSH consultant with child labour experience in coordination with National OSH Inspector at MOM central level targeting 56 of 300 field OSH inspectors across Egypt of field inspectors so far over the course of 3 weeks. The tele-advisory services aim to promote occupational safety and health culture, address the precautionary measures to prevent covid-19, protect children at working age from risks in the workplace, unify concepts between various groups of field inspectors in the different governorates and exchange experiences on the occupational safety and health of workers and employers in the workplace. The Feedback from targeted inspectors was positive and they encouraged their colleagues to join the calls and were eager to find out more.
